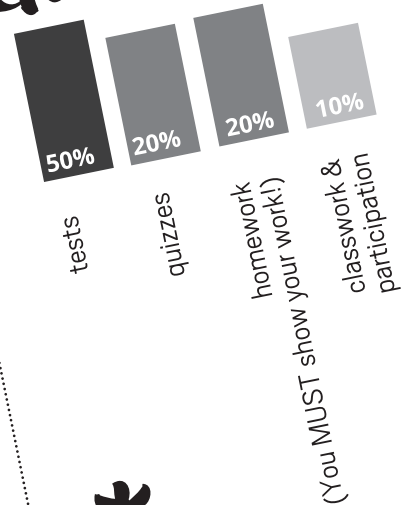

Grades



- Grades will be available on **Powerschool**. I usually update grades weekly.
- Please **check Powerschool regularly**, and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade. I make mistakes, so this is your opportunity to make sure I've got everything correct! This can be done before or after class or via e-mail.
- If you do not have an Powerschool login, you can **get one from the front office**.

Rules & Expectations

RESPECT

- *Students will maintain a respectful and positive attitude toward the teacher and classmates.
- *Be on time! Punctuality is my biggest pet-peeve. On your 3rd tardy, you will receive detention (and each time after that).

BEHAVIOR

- *No sleeping in class. If you sleep, you will stand for the duration of the class period.

RESPONSIBILITY

- *My classroom is a RED classroom; meaning, you should NOT have your cell phone/iPad/laptop/etc. out during class time. There will be a few days during the year where cell phones are allowed. Most of what we do in class requires little technology.

Absent and Late Work Policy

- 1 YES – WE DID SOMETHING IMPORTANT WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT.** It is your responsibility to check with me the day you return to class to find out what you missed. Check the **blue paper organizer (in the back of the room) or class website** to find any handouts you missed.
- 2** You have **ONE DAY for each day you are absent** to make up missed work. After that day, any missing assignments will be accepted for half credit. You have until the end of the NEXT unit to turn in missing/late work

- 3** If you are absent or if you have late work to turn in, turn it into the green basket near the back of the classroom. Make sure you label at the top whether the assignment is late or if you were absent.
- 4** Any assignment you are absent for will be entered as a **ZERO until it is turned in.**

Homework & Other Policies



***Late work IS** accepted for **50% (F)** of the grade.

***EXTRA CREDIT POLICY:** There isn't any. Do the assignments the first time for regular credit.

***TEST/QUIZ RETAKE:** You may retake any test below a C. You may not retake quizzes. You have until 2 weeks after the test is passed back to complete a retake.



***LIFE HAPPENS!** If you are having issues at school or at home, have a huge exam coming up for science, or realize you need more time to complete your absolute best work for any other reason, e-mail me and request an extension. **You must come talk to me or e-mail me the school day before** for the extension to be granted. You cannot come in 5 minutes before or email me at 11pm the night before class and expect an extension.

Test Retakes:

What it is & how to do it

You have the opportunity to retake any test below a 70%. The retake will contain similar questions, mostly with different numbers. The reason? I want you to worry about understanding the material, not worry about what to expect on the test.

In order to retake a test...

- 1 Complete test corrections.** This means going through and redoing every problem you incorrectly answered on the first test, AND explaining why you answered it incorrectly.
- 2 Go over test corrections.** Either during lunch, before/after school, you'll have to go over your corrections to make sure you understand what you got incorrect.
- 3 STUDY YOUR CORRECTIONS.**
